5. Learner gain practical knowledge and skills.

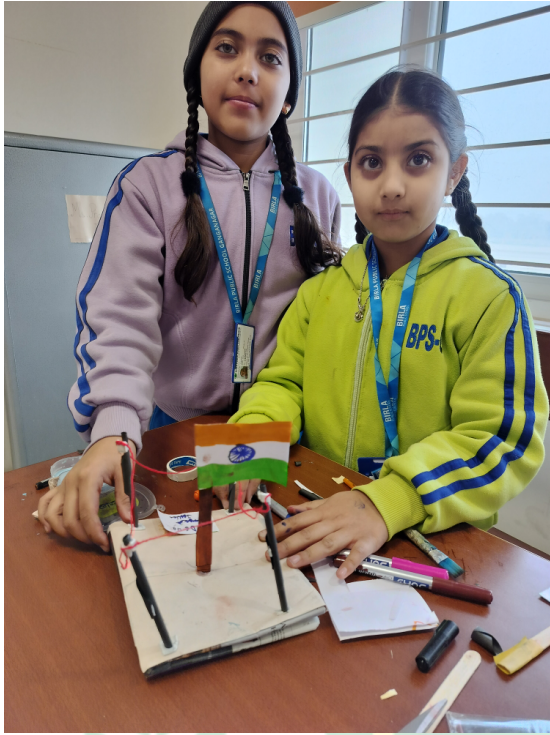
