### **Students’ Admissions**

- During this session, the school has succeeded in getting adequate number of new admissions and sustain the previous admissions, despite the situation & challenges faced during COVID-19 pandemic.

### **Virtual Learning & Progress in BPSG (Online Classes)**

- The teaching & learning is being conducted effectively on Microsoft Teams with active participation of the students. Virtual lessons of activity subjects (Music, Art and Physical Education) are also conducted to enhance the co-curricular skills of the students. The school has conducted successfully online assessments, tests and examinations for III to IX and Evaluation of expressions for Pre-Primary classes. Online PTMs are being held to attend & rectify the parents/ guardians queries regarding academics/performance of their ward and to receive their valuable feedback.

### **CBSE Affiliation and Class IX CBSE Registration**

- The school has received its CBSE Affiliation (CBSE Affiliation No.- 1730974) on dated 05.10.2020.
- The school has received CBSE registration for Class IX.
- In the next session, the school is going to apply and register for Senior Secondary class (Class XI) under CBSE

### **Functions and celebrations**

- It is said that “*life is a celebration of awakenings of new beginnings and wonderful surprises that enlighten the human soul*”. The following national celebrations & festivals were conducted online whereby; students actively contributed their presentations & performances.  
Teacher’s Day, Dussehra, Diwali, National Geographic Day, Christmas, National Youth Day, 72<sup>nd</sup> Republic day, Basant Panchami.
- The school has conducted a Fit India School week (14 to 19 December 2020), wherein students and faculty actively participated while performing fitness activities.

### **Awareness Webinar for Students**

- The school has conducted two days webinar for Dental Awareness (4 & 5 Feb) in collaboration with Surendera Dental College and Research Institute for with practical approach being discussed by the doctors, wherein the students enthusiastically participated to learn dental care tips.

## **Academic Activities**

- A Spell Bee Competition (14 to 16 Sept.) for Classes VI to VIII & word jumble race for Class IV was conducted to acquire vocabularies and to enhance lexical competency in listening, reading, speaking and writing skills.
- An event- AI Experiments by Google was conducted for Class V to aware & excite students regarding the technology Artificial Intelligence with fun-learn online AI-based activities.
- An event- Meet green colour & making tree was conducted for Class Nursery for Recognition of green colour to develop visual ability, spatial intellectual and spread awareness to save tress & save earth
- An event- Video editing was conducted for class IX to edit, design and create a video using text and images.

## **Participation of Students in Inter School and national competitions**

- The school has participated in the “Inter BET Hindi Poem Recitation Competition”. The second and third position was bagged by two students of Class VII (Vanisha Jain) and Class VIII (Nandini Choudhary) in the junior and senior level category respectively.
- 57 students of the school has participated in SPOT (Science Promotion Orient Test) Prelims conducted by VSSF (Vikram Sarabhai Science Foundation) at different levels from 20 to 22 January 2021. 8 students (4 from each level of basic and junior of BPSG qualified in SPOT Prelims. A student of Class III, Sarthak Dalmia topped in the Basic Level (Class 3 to 5)

## **CBSE Events**

- All the BPSG teachers/staff along with their students have read the preamble on National Constitution Day during online session of Hon’ble President of India conducted during this day.
- 43 students of BPSG have participated in the CBSE Expression Series event (16 to 26 February) and expressed about the topics given by the CBSE in the form of /painting/poetry writing/slogan writing/cartoon strip/meme. One best entry from each category (primary, middle and secondary) have been awarded an e-certificate of participation from CBSE.
- The school students and Faculty has attended the webinar on celebration of Matribhasha Diwas (Mother Language Day- 21 February) jointly conducted by Ministry of Education & Ministry of Culture.
- The virtual launch of National School Oral Health Program (27 February) in collaboration with Indian Dental Association (IDA) was attended through virtual mode. The sessions under this program are planned to be conducted by IDA on igezia platform.

## **Reopening of School**

- The reopening of school for Class IX (18 January 2021) and Classes VI to VIII (08 February 2021) has been done with utmost care of student’s safety during COVID- 19. All the necessary safety steps (SMS) as per norms are being followed during the physical classes.
- Birla Public School Ganganagar is the first school in Ganganagar to place specially designed furniture for the safety of students during COVID- 19 for running physical classes.

## **Online Continuous Learning Evaluation & Examinations:**

The school has followed a set designed assessment policy as all the grade level have different learning styles, experiences and abilities, the assessment and evaluation of their learning must be fair and demonstrate full range of the best practices.

- Different types of evaluations were conducted for oral and written expression of the student's learning for Classes Nur to II on a continuous basis throughout the session.
- Two periodic examinations and Term end examinations were conducted online for Classes III to IX. Term 2 examination for Classes VI to IX was conducted offline at school. The internal assessments based on various subject wise subject enrichment parameters was also considered.

## **Parent-Teacher Meets:**

We firmly believe that positive communication between parents and teachers goes a long way in improving the efficacy of education. We ensure the active participation of parents in the teaching-learning process. The Parent Teacher Meeting is organized from time to time to discuss the progress of their wards and positive suggestions for the overall development of the school.

- Time to time online PTM was held with parents by each subject teacher to attend & rectify their queries regarding academics/performance of their ward and to receive their valuable feedback.

## **BET Founder's Day**

- An online live session during BET Founder's Day (16 February)- Award Ceremony & Musical evening was attended by BPSG students and staff.

## **Teachers' Training / Webinars:**

- A workshop was conducted by the Head of the School, BPSG on 13<sup>th</sup> October for the teachers to motivate & boost them and to remain happy & spread happiness. Team building & different activities were conducted during this session.
- The BPSG Faculty have attended a session of the resource person Ms. Veena Raizada in the month of January (15<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> January) & February (3<sup>rd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> February 2021). The session comprised the PBL approach to curriculum, methods of teaching methods by inquiry-based learning and collaborative teaching & learning.
- A session was attended by two faculty members of Science Department based on Structure and establishment of Labs (General Science Lab, Chemistry, Physics and Biology) with BIS faculty.
- On 7<sup>th</sup> January 2021, The BPSG Faculty has attended a session as a feedback session of ABEA Workshop. Different speakers from all the BET schools have put forth their presentations, covering major points like Rethinking Assessments- (various kinds of learning assessment tools), blended learning, Project Based Learning (PBL), teaching & learning theories and practices, increased engagement in class, behaviourism and constructionism, designing of lesson plan, NEP 2020, challenges and remedies in various stages of teaching and learning.
- On 25<sup>th</sup> January 2021, A workshop on Art Integration was attended by the BPSG faculty of English department, Hindi department and Social Science department on how art can be integrated in various subjects to make the subjects interesting and engaging.

- On 15<sup>th</sup> December 2021, The BPSG Faculty has attended a webinar on Professional Development, conducted by the resource person Ms. Shalini Nambiar (15 December) on the topics strategies to make virtual classes engaging and impactful and designing creative assessments.
