Raksha Bandhan Celebration

Dear Parents/ Students

Raksha Bandhan is a special occasion to celebrate the bond of love between a brother and a sister by tying a sacred thread around the wrist. This thread with love is rightly called the Rakhi since it means "a bond of protection".

This year, BPSG is going to redefine the festival of Raksha Bandhan as an occasion of re- establishing the fading bond of protection between Human and Nature by following activities:

- 1. Tie Rakhi to Plants or stray animals and pledge to protect them.
- 2. Celebrate this Rakha Bandhan in orphanage home or old age home by tying Rakhi and making them feel protected.
- 3. Rakhis with seeds to strengthen bond with nature

(These rakhis, as the name suggests, will be made of biodegradable material and will contain pockets or clay seals filled with seeds of herbal and flowering plants. Instead of being discarded after the festival, the rakhis can be planted in the soil)
