Bring a Little Beauty: Handwriting Competition (July 8, 2024)



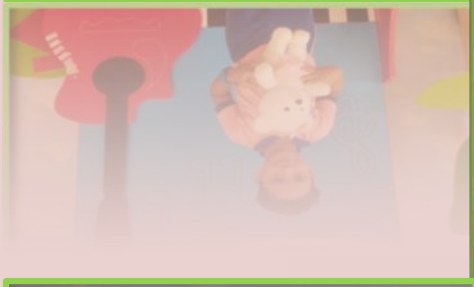
"Beautiful Handwriting, Bright Minds!"

Grade IX Political Science Event: {Youth Parliament} (July 24, 2024)



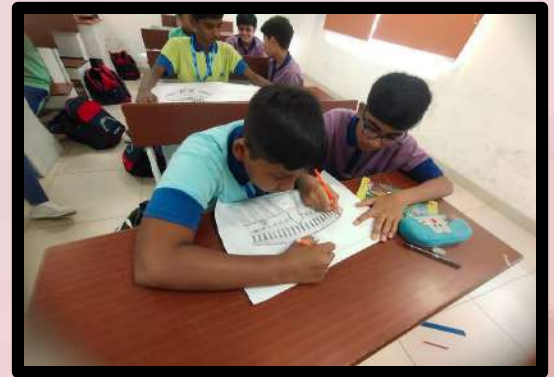
“Empowering voices, shaping futures.”

"Empowering Young Minds for a Democratic Future"

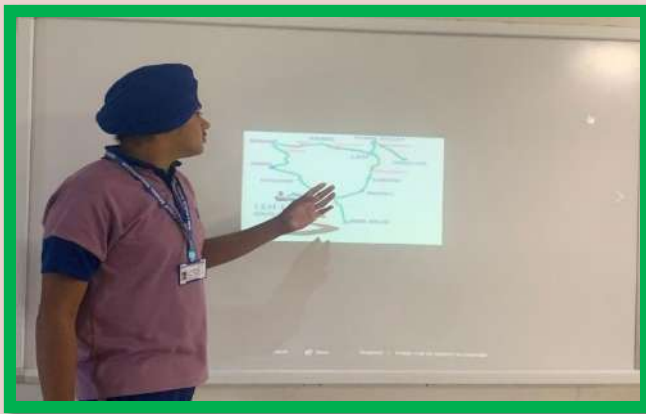

(July 24 , 2024)



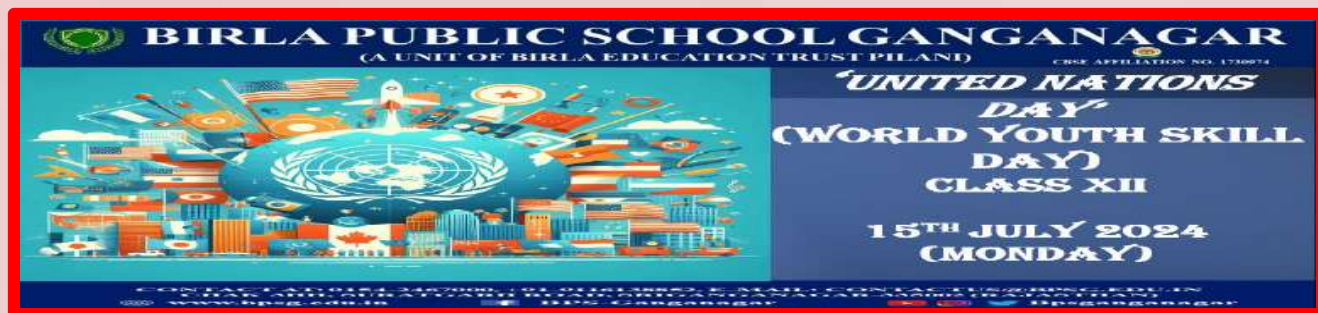
"Exploring the world's mysteries, one creative step at a time."

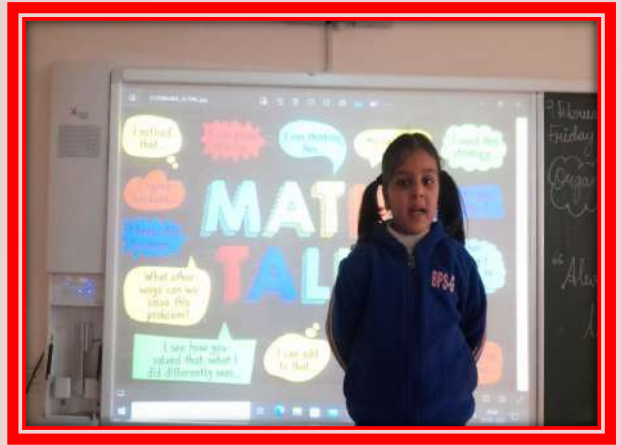
Basant Panchami in Pilani *(February 08, 2024)*
