Outcome of the Activity:

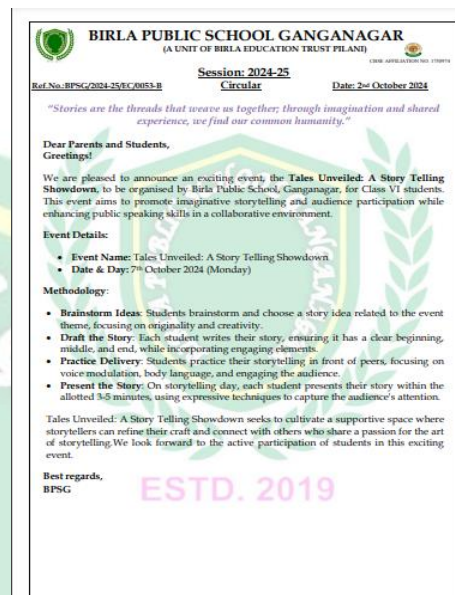
- **Creativity and Critical Thinking:** The students developed creative thinking through character analysis and performance.

Result:

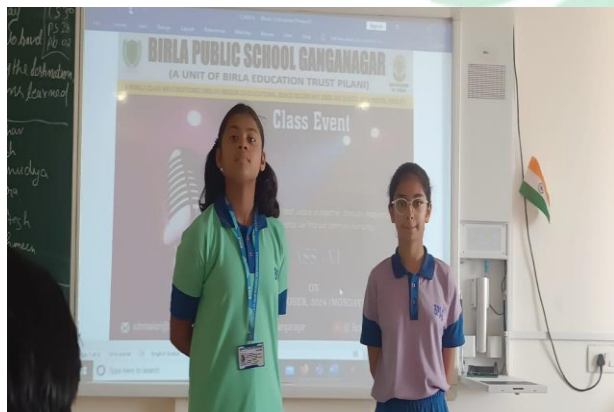
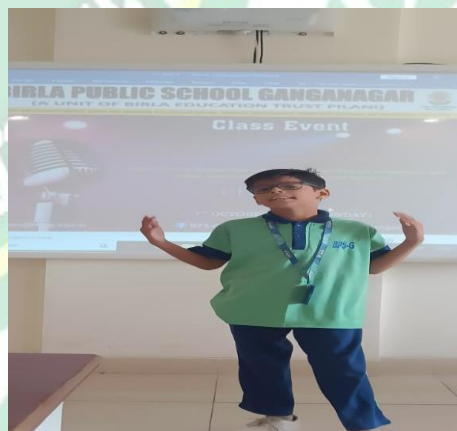
Since the event was designed to be non-competitive, every student had the opportunity to
