#### Students' Admission

- During this session, the school has succeeded in getting the adequate number of new admissions and sustaining the previous admissions, despite the situation & challenges faced during the COVID-19 pandemic, with an increase of 115 new admissions, making it to a total of 450 students till date and still ongoing.

#### Virtual Learning & Progress in BPSG (Online Classes)

- The teaching & learning is being conducted effectively on Microsoft Teams with the active participation of the students. Virtual lessons of activity subjects (Music, Art and Physical Education) are also conducted to enhance the co-curricular skills of the students. The school has conducted successfully online assessments, tests and examinations for III to IX and Evaluation of expressions for Pre-Primary classes. Online PTMs are being held to attend & rectify the parents/ guardians queries regarding academics/performance of their ward and to receive their valuable feedback.

#### CBSE Affiliation and Class XI CBSE Registration

- The school is affiliated with CBSE Affiliation No. 1730974 upto Secondary class (Class X).
- In this session, the school is going to apply and register for Senior Secondary class (Class XI) under CBSE.

#### Reopening of School

- The school was reopened as per grade level i.e., Class IX & X (01.09.2021), Classes VI to VIII (20.09.2021) and Classes I to V (28.09.2021) with utmost care of student's safety during the COVID- 19. All the necessary safety steps (SMS) as per norms are being followed during the physical classes.
- Birla Public School Ganganagar is the first school in Ganganagar to place specially designed furniture for the safety of students during the COVID- 19 for running physical classes.

#### Continuous Learning Evaluation & Examinations:

The school is following a set designed assessment policy as all the grade level have different learning styles, experiences and abilities, the assessment and evaluation of their learning must be fair and demonstrate the full range of the best practices.

- A continuous evaluation process is being followed for oral and written expression of the student's learning for Classes Nur to II throughout the session.
- Two periodic examinations and two term end examinations is being planned for Classes III to VIII. The internal assessments based on various subject wise enrichment parameters were also considered.
- For Classes IX and X, the CBSE examination pattern is being followed for all the major and minor subjects.

#### Parent-Teacher Meets:

We firmly believe that positive communication between parents and teachers goes a long way in improving the efficacy of education. We ensure the active participation of parents in the teaching-learning process. The Parent Teacher Meetings were organized from time to time to discuss the progress of their wards and received positive suggestions for the overall development of the school.
