



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3rd Day of Holistic Week- Mother's Day Celebration

The aim of the workshop was to enhance the teachers' understanding of writing anecdotal records for students, emphasizing the importance of accurate and objective documentation as per the recommendation of NEP 2020. The session also included valuable insights from the school's Principal, who provided rubrics and explanations related to various aspects of student development. Throughout the session, the teachers had shared their approaches to writing anecdotal records, emphasizing the importance of recording observations and interpretations. It is essential to focus solely on what has been witnessed, without adding personal biases or judgments. The Principal, in the session shared her insightful guidance on the procedure for writing an anecdotal record which involves careful and systematic documentation. It begins with selecting a specific event or moment to observe, ensuring that it is relevant to the student's learning or behaviour. Then, it is crucial to provide a detailed and accurate account of what transpired, capturing both verbal and non-verbal cues. She further emphasized the importance of including contextual information in our anecdotal records. This includes the date, time, and any relevant factors that might have influenced the observed behaviour. The goal is to create a holistic and comprehensive record that provides valuable insights into the student's overall development. The rubrics and explanations related to self-awareness, problem-solving, dealing with challenges, interpersonal relations, creative thinking, managing feelings and emotions, communication, and empathy added significant value to the workshop, offering a holistic perspective on student development. The workshop successfully equipped teachers with the necessary knowledge and skills to effectively write anecdotal records that contribute to student's growth and understanding. This enables a fair and accurate representation of the student's behaviour, strengths, and areas that may require additional support. The teachers were engaged in a brainstorming session and delivered a comprehensive PowerPoint Presentation outlining the process of composing an Anecdotal Record.




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July 07, 2023- V- In- House Workshop: Adaptability - "Be Flexible in a Changing World."


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July 18, 2023- S. St Event (Media Tek)


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August 24, 2023- UKG- A Meet-Up with Grandparents


