A more supportive and encouraging environment where students uplift each other in their journeys of learning.

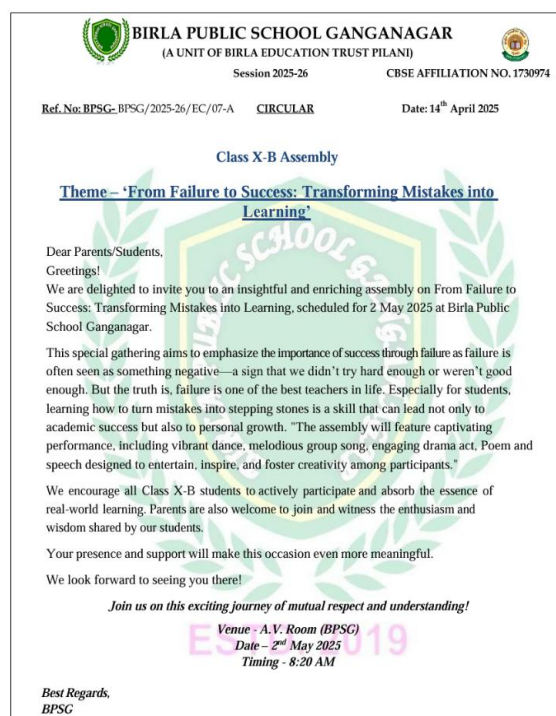
5. Increased Motivation and Goal-setting:
