(September 01, 2023)




"Creativity is seeing what others can't see and thinking what no one else has ever thought."

(September 05, 2023)




“The duties of a teacher are neither few nor small, but they elevate the mind and give energy to the character.”

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Cooking Club Event: Zaika (September 06, 2023)





"Cooking is like love, it should be entered into with complete abandon or not at all."

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Grade VII Hindi Event: दोहा एवं चौपाई गायन (September 06, 2023)






"Hindi is the soul of our nation, the bridge between diverse communities."

“Hindi is a legacy we must cherish and preserve for generations to come.”





“Creativity is allowing yourself to make mistakes. Art is knowing which ones to keep.”



“The goal of early childhood education should be to activate the child’s own natural desire to learn.”



“The art of communication is the language of leadership.”



“Poetry is just the evidence of life. If your life is burning well, poetry is just the ash. Poetry is thoughts that breathe, and words that burn.”



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Grade IV Event: Tang Your Story (October 10, 2023)







“Language is not mathematics where we can draw the lowest value and the highest value; It is the flow of thoughts, emotions, surroundings and culture etc.”

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Grade IX Mathematics Event: Vertex Fellowship (November 04, 2023)






(November 18, 2023)




“The real competition is not against the other contestants,; it is against yourself, to surpass your own limits.”

Grade VII Punjabi Event: Kavitva (November 21, 2023)




