EVENT REPORT

Event Name: Inter House Art Competition

Day & Date-05- 07- 2025 (Saturday)

Objective of the Activity:

The objective of the Inter House Art Competition was to foster imagination, enhance artistic skills, and provide a platform for students to express their creativity through visual art. The event aimed at promoting self-expression, appreciation of art, and encouraging healthy inter-house competition among students across various classes.

No. of Participants:

Selected students from Classes III, IV-V, VI-VIII, and IX & XI from all Houses participated. House Teachers shortlisted students during trial rounds held on 2nd July 2025. Staff members and House In-Charges facilitated the event.

Brief Note About the Event:

The **Inter House Art Competition** was conducted with enthusiasm and creativity on 5th July 2025. Participants were divided into four categories:

1. **Cartoon Creation** – Class III
2. **Cartoon Creation** – Classes IV-V
3. **Portrait Power** – Classes VI-VIII
4. **Abstract Emotions** – Classes IX & XI

Students were given topics **on the spot** and worked using specified mediums like pencil colours, crayons, pastels, watercolours, acrylics, and collages. A4 cartridge sheets were used as the standard medium. The school campus was filled with vibrant and expressive artworks reflecting students' perspectives and imagination.

The competition was judged on creativity, relevance to the topic, technique, and overall presentation. House Teachers, Art Teachers, and faculty ensured smooth execution and support throughout the event.

Outcome of the Activity:

1. **Enhanced Creativity and Expression:**
Students displayed a wide range of artistic expressions, from fun and humorous cartoon sketches to deep and conceptual abstract themes.
2. **Encouraged Team Spirit and Healthy Competition:**

Trial Details & Art Medium

Trials - Will be held on **Wednesday, 2 July 2025** during CT period.

- ❖ **Class III** - Sketch colours or pencil colours
- ❖ **Classes IV & V** - Pastel or crayon
- ❖ **Classes VI - VIII** - Pencil shading (black & white), soft pastel/oil pastel.
- ❖ **Classes IX - XII** - Watercolour, acrylic colour or paper collage (use newspaper caption or magazine)
- ❖ Cartridge paper A4 size is to be used by all the categories.

Important Guidelines

- ❖ Participants will be selected by the respective House Teachers on trial basis.
- ❖ Students must bring their own art supplies as mentioned above for trials and for the final competition day too.
- ❖ Absentees and new admissions will be allowed as per their interest.
- ❖ Number of students selected per house categories wise -
 - III - 5 each house
 - IV - V - 10 each House
 - VI - VIII - 10 each House
 - IX & XI - 5 each House
- ❖ Topics will be given on the spot for each competition.
- ❖ Judging will be based on creativity, relevance to the topic, technique, and overall presentation.
