Brief Note about the Activity:

Students presented stories using **puppets, skits, dialogue delivery, and dramatic expressions**, incorporating elements like voice modulation, props, and gestures. The non-competitive event encouraged confidence, creativity, and a deeper connection with books. All performances were appreciated, and special mentions were given for outstanding effort and creativity. It was a joyful and enriching experience for all.

Outcome of the Activity:

- **Improved Expression and Confidence**
Students practiced speaking clearly and with expression in front of an audience.
- **Creative Use of Drama**
They used puppets, costumes, and actions to tell stories in exciting ways.
- **Teamwork and Cooperation**
Many activities involved working in pairs or groups, which taught cooperation and **sharing** ideas.
- **Love for Reading and Performing**
Theatre Day made reading more enjoyable and helped students connect with books in a **new** way.

The event was non-competitive and focused on participation, creativity, and enjoyment. All performances were appreciated for their originality, effort, and enthusiasm. Special mentions were given to participants that displayed excellent content creativity, delivery and opinion.

Conclusion:

The event proved more than a display – it became a meaningful learning experience. Students reflected on books not just in terms of plot, but in the way characters changed, how messages in books related to their lives. They expressed themselves in ways they had not tried before: performing, drawing, speaking. Confidence among students increased.

- To introduce students to the fundamentals of theatre in a joyful and accessible way.

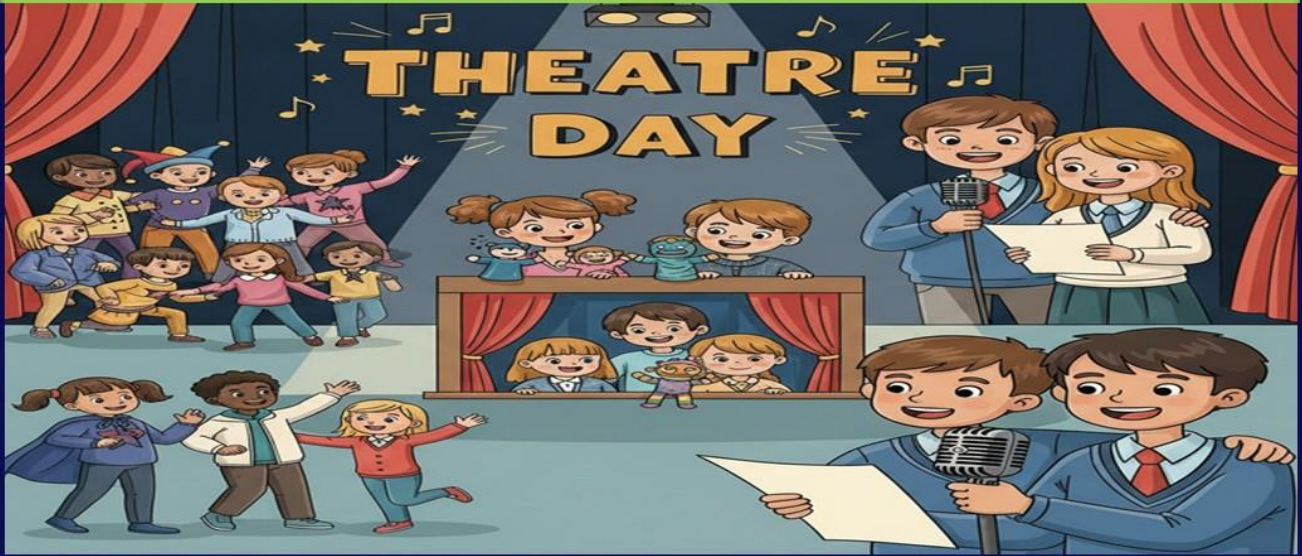
General Instructions for Students

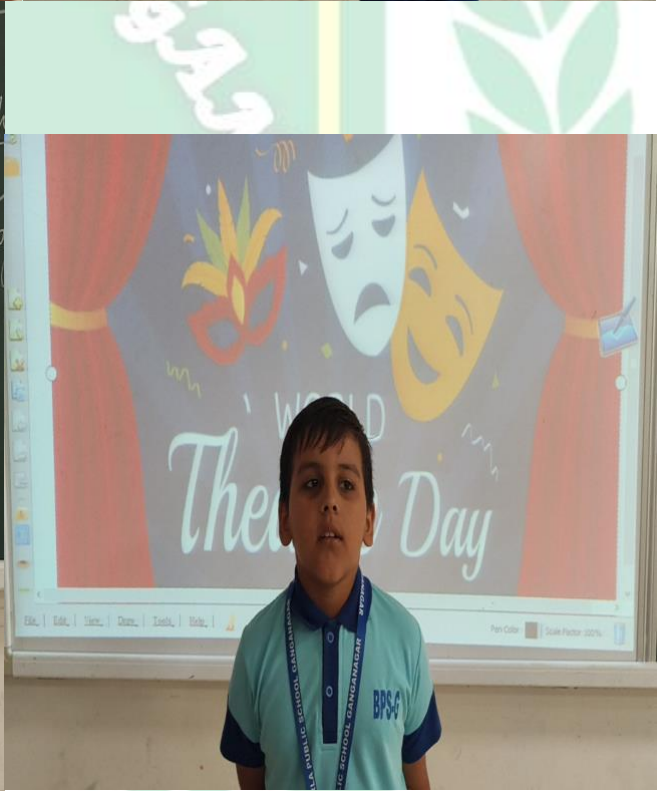
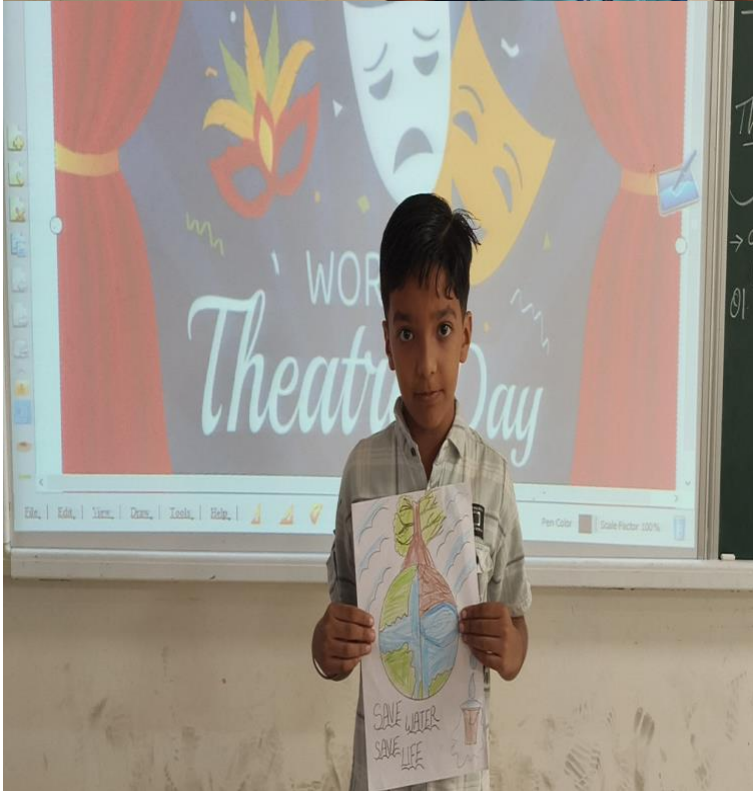
