Topic: "Book Review"

Objective of the Activity:

The event aimed to motivate students to read more widely, including genres they had not tried before. It aimed to make them more aware of literary devices – such as symbolism, irony, and point of view. It aimed to strengthen their writing and speaking skills by having them prepare reviews that included both summary and critique. It aimed to encourage teamwork for those who worked in pairs or groups. It aimed to make reading enjoyable, not just a chore, by giving students choices and allowing creative modes of presentation.

No. of Participants: 71 (VA, VB and VC)

Brief Note about the Activity:

The **Book Review** event provided a dynamic platform for Class V students to creatively express their reflections on books they had read. Participants selected a book and presented their reviews through various formats such as skits, comic strips, posters, or oral presentations. The event encouraged students to delve deeper into the themes, characters, and narratives of their chosen books, fostering a deeper appreciation for literature. By engaging in this creative exercise, students not only enhanced their analytical skills but also developed confidence in sharing their insights with peers.

Outcome of the Activity:

1. Improved Critical Thinking

Students analyzed themes, characters, and plot structures in the books they reviewed.

2. Enhanced Communication Skills

They presented their insights through various creative formats, such as skits, posters, and oral reviews.

3. Increased Engagement with Reading

The event sparked a deeper interest in exploring diverse genres and authors.

4. Boosted Confidence

Students gained confidence in public speaking and learned the value of collaborative efforts.

Results:

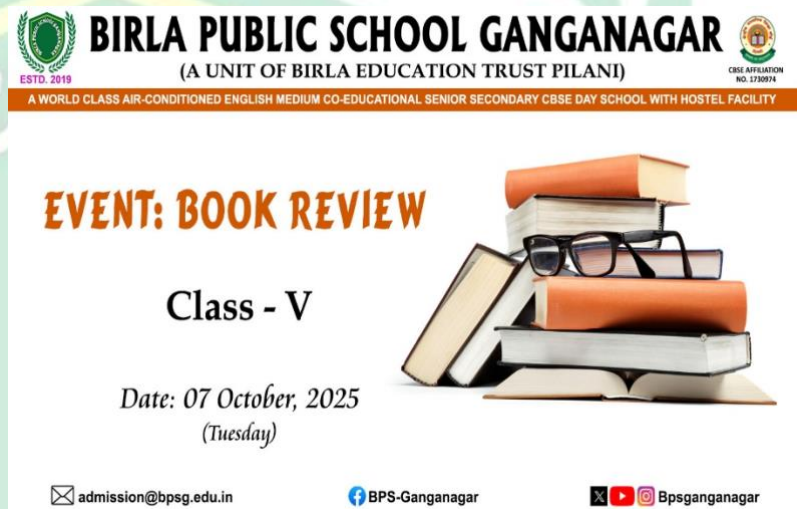

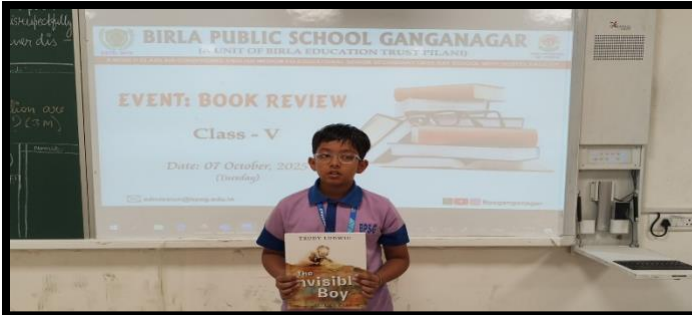
