Topic: "Story Quest"

Objective of the Activity:

The **Story Quest** event aimed to:

- Enhance students' storytelling skills by encouraging them to narrate stories from memory.

Brief Note about the Activity:

The **Story Quest** event provided Class VIII students with an exciting opportunity to showcase their storytelling skills. Participants were invited to narrate a story – be it a folk tale, personal experience, myth, or an original creation – in their own words. The emphasis was on engaging the audience through expressive language, tone, and gestures, rather than reading aloud. This approach not only enhanced their confidence and public speaking abilities but also fostered creativity and imagination. The event successfully transformed storytelling into a dynamic and interactive experience, allowing students to connect with their peers through the art of narration.

Outcome of the Activity:

- **Enhanced Storytelling Skills:** Students effectively engaged their audience using expressive language, tone, and gestures.
- **Increased Confidence:** Students delivered their stories with clarity and enthusiasm.
- **Fostered Creativity:** Students presented original and imaginative stories.

The event was non-competitive and focused on participation, creativity, and enjoyment. All performances were appreciated for their originality, effort, and enthusiasm. Special mentions were given to participants that displayed excellent content creativity, delivery and opinion.
