- 4. Harmonious Blending of Voices:** Participants displayed excellent harmony, vocal control, and dynamics, leaving the audience mesmerized.


Outcomes of the Event:

- Final selection will be based on these trials.
- "Each house should prepare a solo performance by one student" for a 3-4 minute performance ,using any one musical instrument.
- Prepare well in advance to ensure a smooth and melodious performance!

Note: 2-3 minutes for instrumental. Students are free to prepare for the instrumental. One student will be selected for the final competition from Classes VII-XII.
