- Debate on "Is Population a Resource or a Burden?"

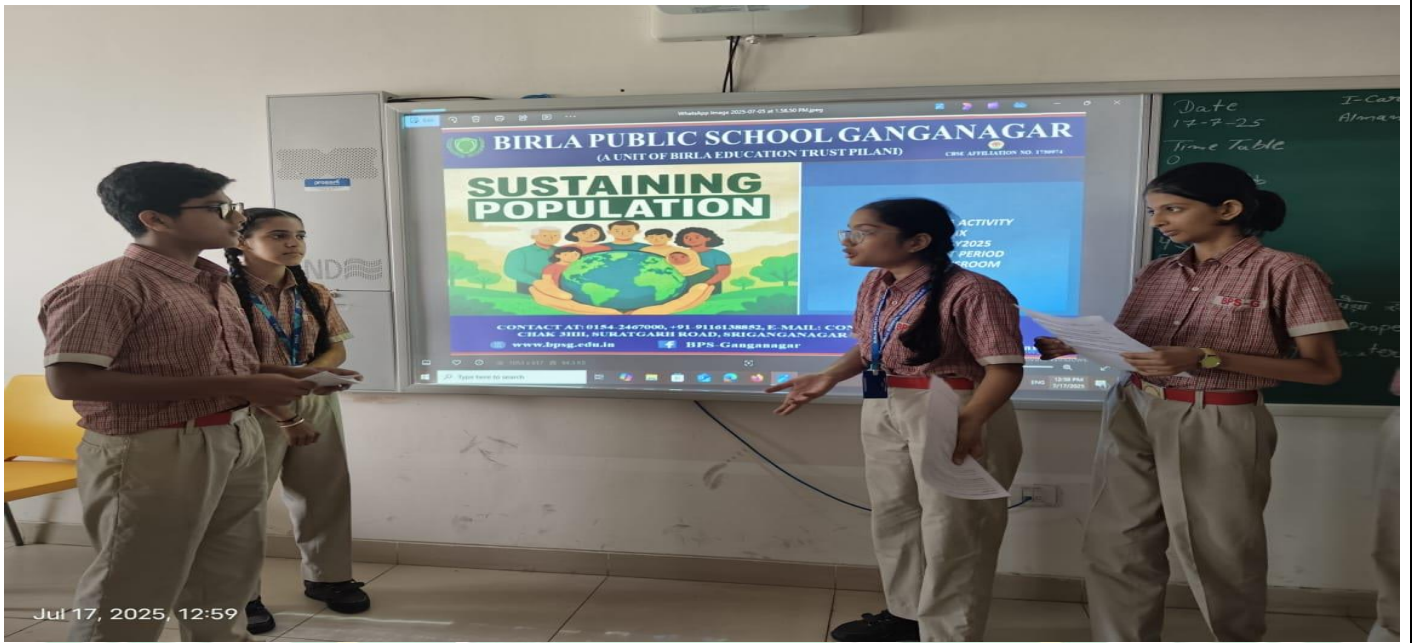
