- To foster collaborative learning and encourage creativity in explaining scientific concepts.

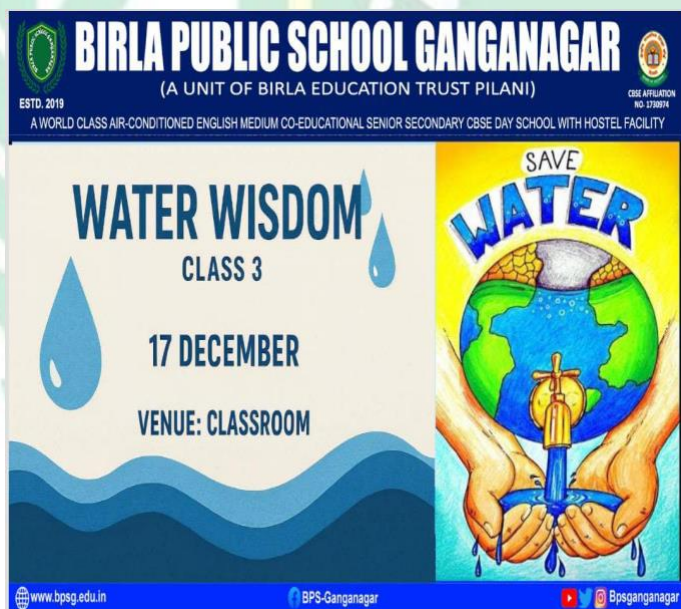
Outcome of the Activity:
