“From Pink City to the Capital: An Educational Journey Across Jaipur, Agra, Delhi, and Haryana”

Students of Classes V to VII of Birla Public School Ganganagar undertook a grand seven-day educational excursion with the aim of holistic development and practical learning, exploring the rich historical and cultural heritage of Jaipur, Agra, Delhi, and Pratapgarh Farm (Haryana) from 24 to 30 December. On 27 December, the group experienced rural life at Pratapgarh Farm, enjoying traditional games, camel and bullock cart rides, and interactive village activities that connected them with India’s grassroots culture. The journey then continued to Agra, where students marveled at the world-renowned Taj Mahal, explored Fatehpur Sikri, Jodha Bai Palace, and the majestic Buland Darwaza, enriching their understanding of Mughal history. In the final phase of the tour, students visited Qutub Minar, the National Science Museum, Rajghat, the National War Memorial, and India Gate in Delhi, gaining valuable perspectives on India’s freedom struggle, scientific progress, and national pride. The excursion was successfully guided by experienced teachers Ms. Bhimakshi, Mrs. Khushboo, Ms. Jyoti, Ms. Neha and Mr. Rajeev, who ensured students’ safety while also explaining the historical and educational significance of each site in detail. Reflecting on the tour, the respected Principal, Dr. Nitesh Kumar Singh, emphasized that such excursions enhance students’ confidence and enable them to witness and understand history beyond textbooks. The group returned safely to the school campus on the morning of 30 December, where they were warmly welcomed by parents and the school community, marking the successful conclusion of a truly enriching educational journey.
