

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Marking a Milestone: 7th Foundation Day (April 5, 2025)




“This day reminds us of our mission — to shape each learner into a beacon of purpose, character, and potential.”

(April 25, 2025)




"In the heart of every challenge lies a seed of transformation."

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International Workers' Day (May 1, 2025)




“With hands that serve and hearts that toil, they build the world we live in.”


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Cooking Club-Event

“We won’t have a society if we destroy the environment.”



(July 17, 2025)




"The greatest threat to our planet is the belief that someone else will save it."

(July 17, 2025)







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Grade- XI- Social Science Event Political Science Constitution Day (July 17, 2025)




"The Constitution is the foundation of our democracy, guiding us towards justice, equality, and unity."

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Grade- XI- Social Science Event Economics Numeric Navigator (July 17, 2025)




"Economics is not just about numbers—it's about understanding the story behind the data, the people it affects, and the decisions it drives."


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Grade- XII- Social Science Event

(July 18, 2025)






