(2nd–3rd August) 2025





“Where talent meets teamwork, creativity blossoms into unforgettable moments.”



(27th August 2025)





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Inter House English Debate Competition (September 03, 2025)





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Literacy Club Event (September 10, 2025)





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Verbattle Club Event: “Talk Titans” (October 29, 2025)






