Maths Mahotsav: Celebrating Numbers, Logic, and Integrity at Birla Public School Ganganagar

On Monday, 22 December 2025, on the auspicious occasion of National Mathematics Day, Birla Public School Ganganagar organised an Inter-School Maths Quiz Competition to commemorate the birth anniversary of the great Indian mathematician Srinivasa Ramanujan. The event aimed to develop logical reasoning, foster interest in numbers, and enhance problem-solving skills among students. The programme began with the ceremonial lighting of the lamp in the gracious presence of the Chief Guest, Dr. Ashwini Kumar, Principal of Maharaja Agrasen College, Suratgarh, and the Guest of Honour, Mr. Anil Saharan, a distinguished alumnus of the school. The Principal of Birla Public School Ganganagar, Dr. Nitesh Kumar Singh, warmly welcomed all the guests and participating teams.

The competition was thoughtfully designed to be both challenging and engaging, comprising a Preliminary Round with multiple-choice questions, hands-on learning activities such as Tangram puzzles, and Sudoku, followed by a Final Round in which four shortlisted teams competed in seven rounds including Rapid Fire, visual diagram-based questions, and reasoning-based tasks. Several prominent schools from the region participated, making the event a true academic celebration. Although Birla Public School Ganganagar secured the highest score in the competition, the school, being the host, chose to remain neutral and graciously relinquished its position in the spirit of fairness and sportsmanship. As a result, the First Prize was awarded to Floradale Public School, the first runner-up, while Saraswati Public School, originally placed third, was awarded the Second Prize.

In his address, Principal Dr. Nitesh Kumar Singh emphasised that mathematics should not be feared but befriended, as it is not merely a subject of numbers but an essential part of everyday life that strengthens logical thinking and decision-making abilities. The event was successfully conducted with the dedicated efforts of the Mathematics Department, with valuable contributions from Mr. Ramesh Kumar (Head of Department), Mr. Sandeep Chauhan, Mr. Mukesh, Mrs. Payal, and Ms. Bhimakshi. The Chief Guest, Dr. Ashwini Kumar, inspired students to explore the beauty and depth of mathematics with curiosity and confidence. The programme concluded with the National Anthem followed by a group photograph, marking the Maths Mahotsav as a meaningful celebration of knowledge, integrity, and academic excellence.
