Month: April 2025

The following events (activities/workshops/sessions) were conducted in the month of April 2025.

1. 1st April 2025 – Commencement of New Academic Session

Birla Public School Ganganagar began its new academic session on 1st April 2025 with a spiritual Hawan ceremony, attended by students, teachers, and staff. The ritual, accompanied by Vedic mantras, aimed to purify the surroundings and inspire students to approach the year with dedication.
