Aim of the Activity:

The activity aims to make Mathematics an exciting journey of exploration and discovery. It encourages students to think critically, solve challenges creatively, and develop a deeper understanding of mathematical concepts through engaging tasks and problem-solving quests.

✦ **Activities:** Students are required to prepare **any one** of the following at home and present it in class on the day of the event:

- ◆ **Math Treasure Hunt Sheet:** Design a set of clues or riddles based on mathematical concepts (numbers, operations, shapes, etc.) leading to a final answer.
- ◆ **Problem-Solving Quest Board:** Create a sequence of math challenges (like levels in a game) where each step leads to the next solution.
- ◆ **Math Story Quest:** Prepare a short story involving characters solving mathematical problems (addition, subtraction, fractions, etc.).
- ◆ **Puzzle Challenge Board:** Design a board with tricky puzzles, brain teasers, or logical reasoning questions along with their solutions.
- ◆ **Real-Life Math Quest:** Create a chart or model showing how mathematics is used in daily life (shopping, time, money, measurement, etc.) with small problem-based tasks.

Instructions:

- The work should be neat, creative, and age-appropriate.
- Students must be able to explain their activity confidently.
- Use easily available materials for preparation.
