Class III Computer Activity: “Draw with AI” (December 2, 2025)



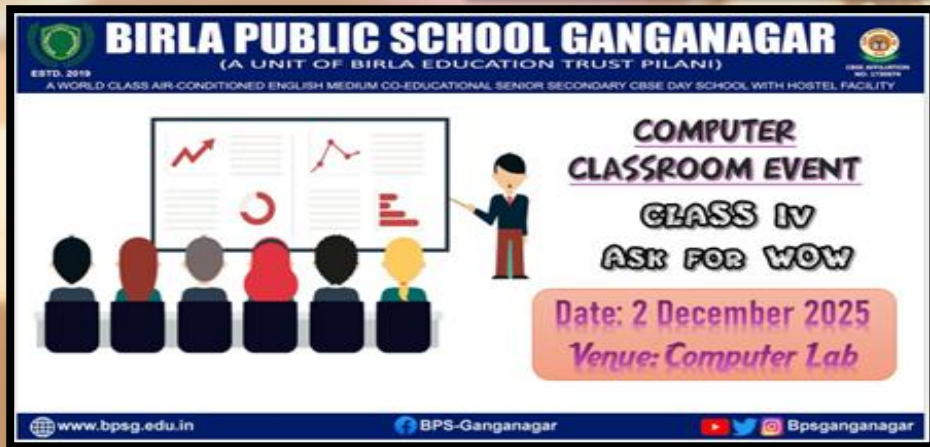
“Introducing young minds to the joy of AI-powered art.”

Class IV Computer Activity: “Ask for wow- The Power Point Presentation” (December 2, 2025)



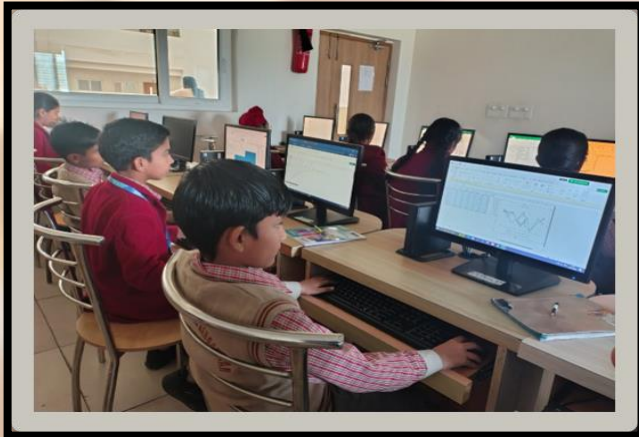
“From thoughts to slides—students discovered the WOW factor.”

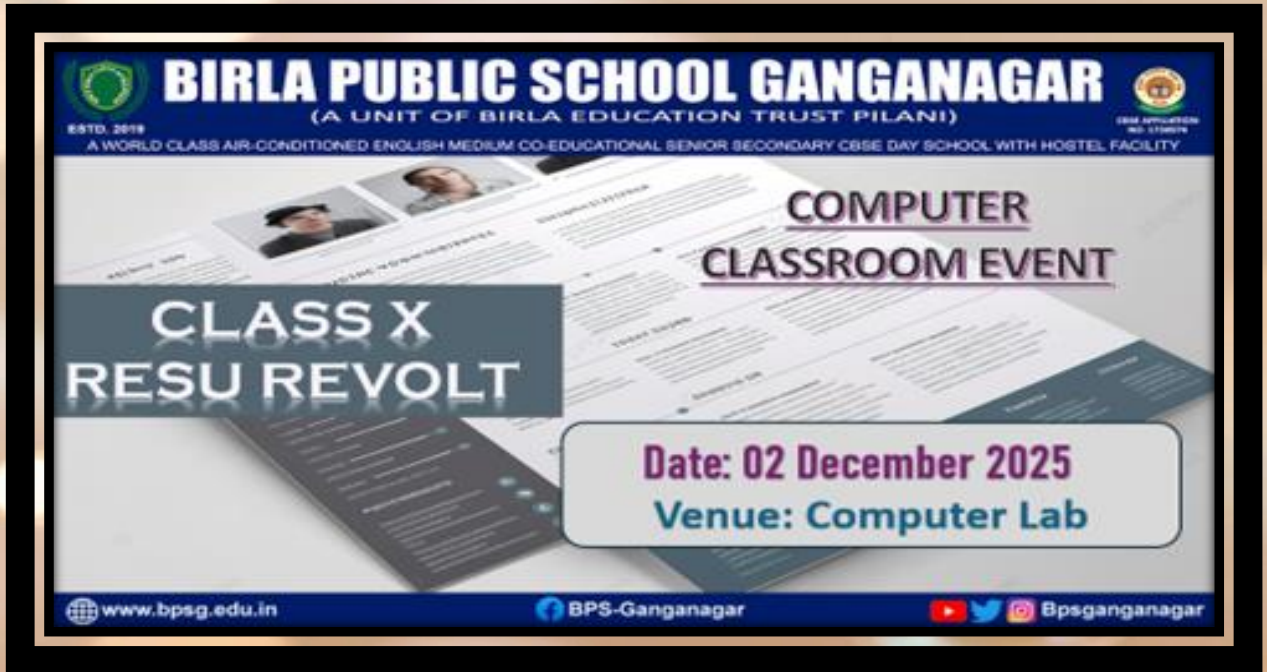

“Preparing students for opportunities beyond the classroom.”

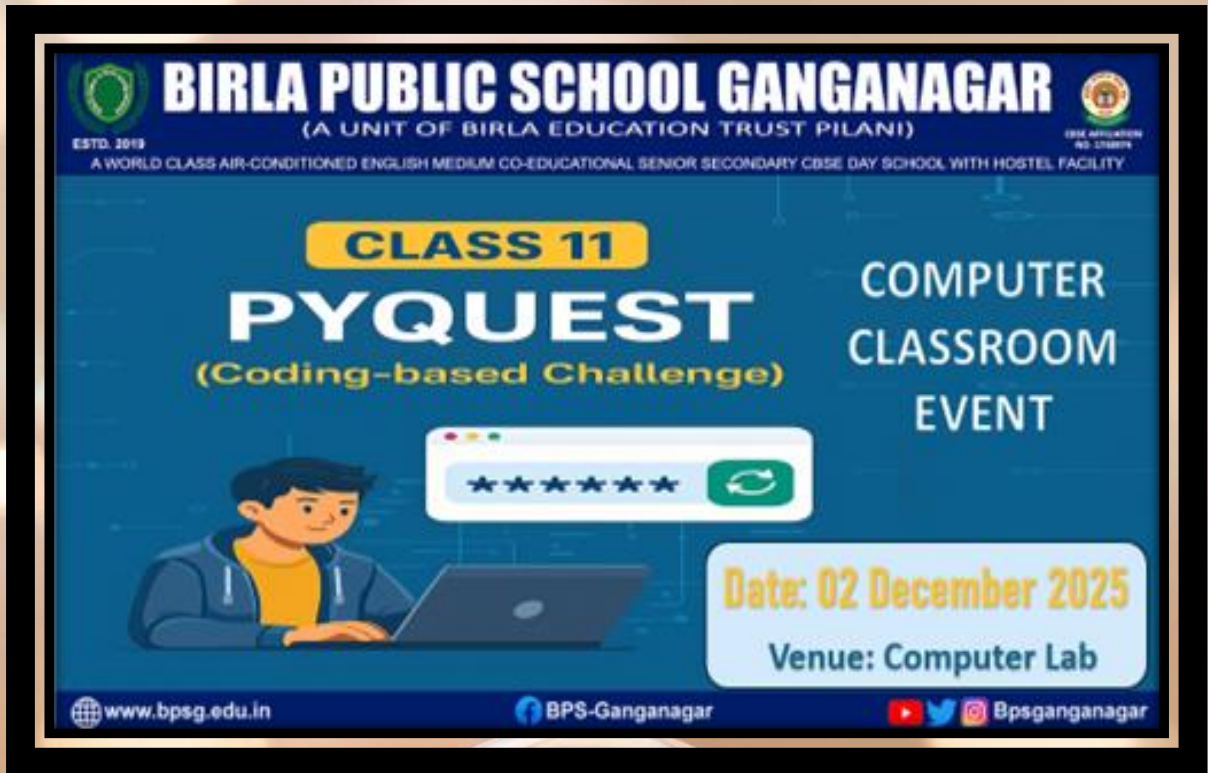

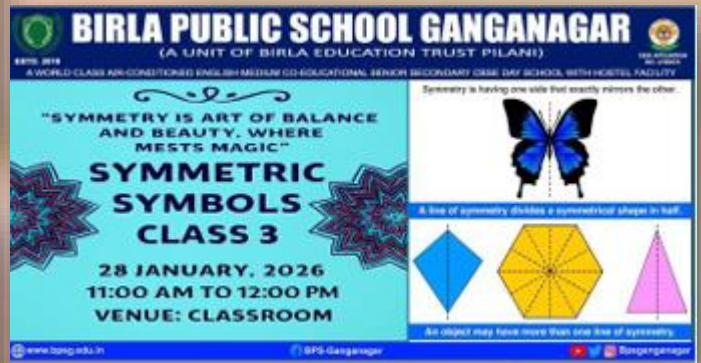

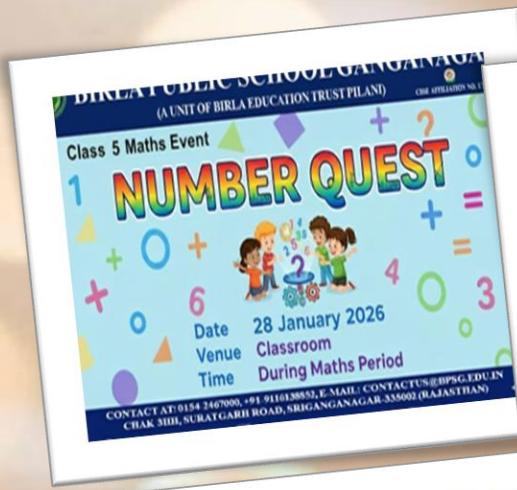

The *Mathangles* activity was conducted for Class VII with the objective of enhancing students' creativity and deepening their understanding of angles through engaging tasks.

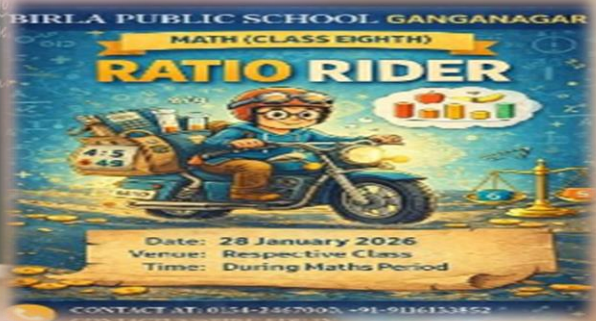

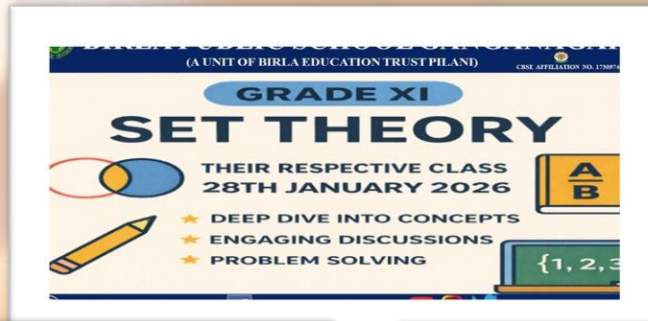
The activity included engaging and interactive games that helped students explore concepts in a fun and practical way. Students displayed confidence while presenting their ideas and worked collaboratively with their peers.

Students also learned that Sri Ganganagar is known for leading Kinnu production due to its favourable climate and fertile soil.
