Outcomes of the Activities:

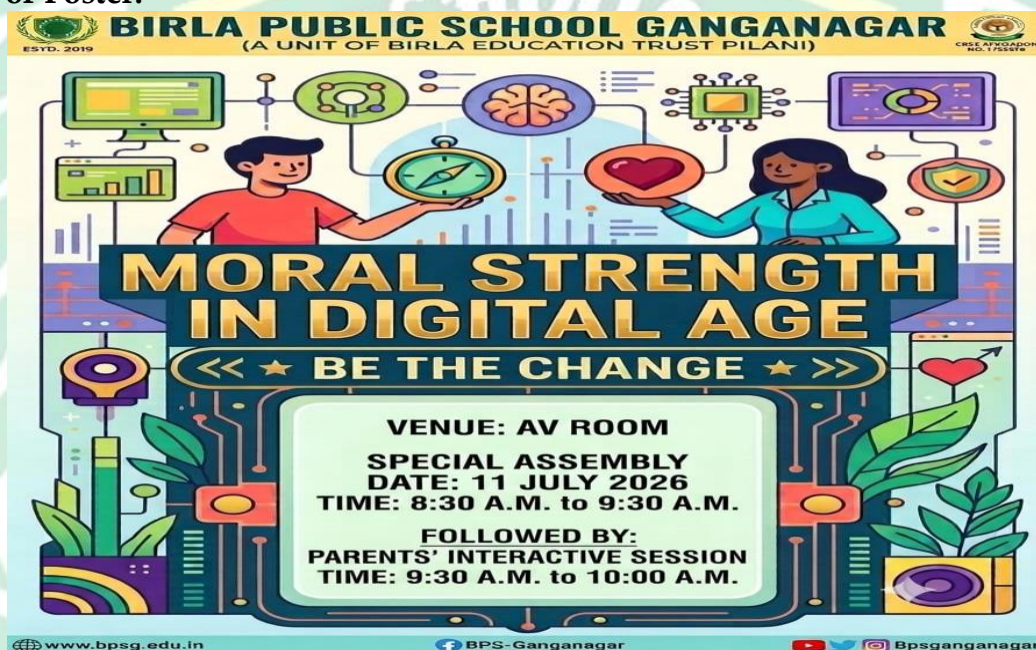
