Objective of the Activity:

Brief Note About the Activity:

- 1. Poster-Making Activity:** Students created posters on two key topics – the **Harappan Civilization** and the **Lion Capital of Ashoka**. The posters depicted aspects such as urban planning in Harappa, seals, the Great Bath, and the symbolic elements of the Lion Capital, which is now India's national emblem. The posters were evaluated for creativity, historical accuracy, and presentation.
- 2. Speech Presentations:** Selected students gave short speeches on the **Harappan Civilization** and the **Chola Dynasty**. The speeches highlighted major achievements such as the Harappan drainage system, trade practices, and script, as well as the Chola Dynasty's contributions to administration, temple architecture, and maritime trade.

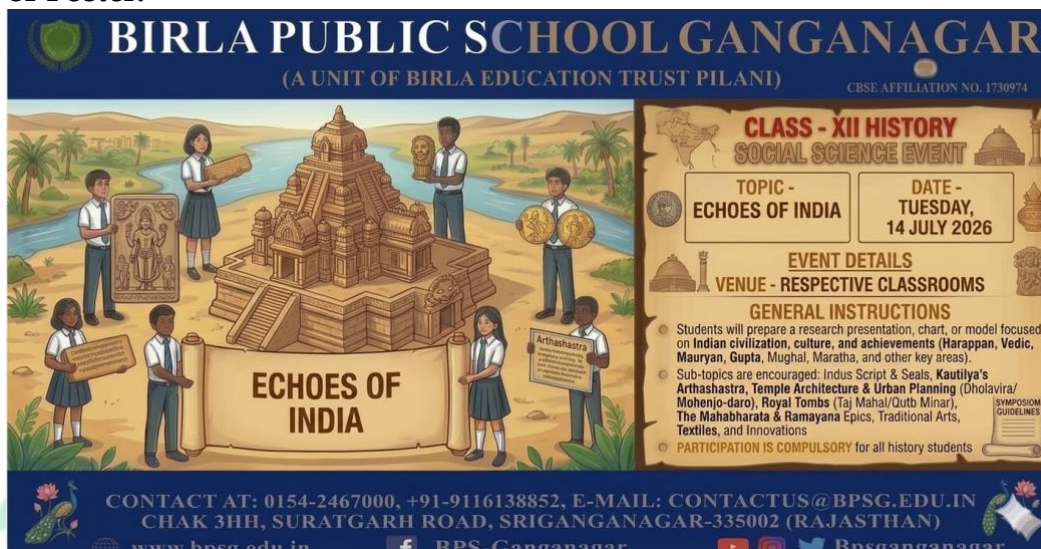
Outcomes of the Activities:

The activity emphasized collective learning over competition. All participants showed commendable engagement and creativity. Each student was recognized for their unique contribution and was appreciated equally.

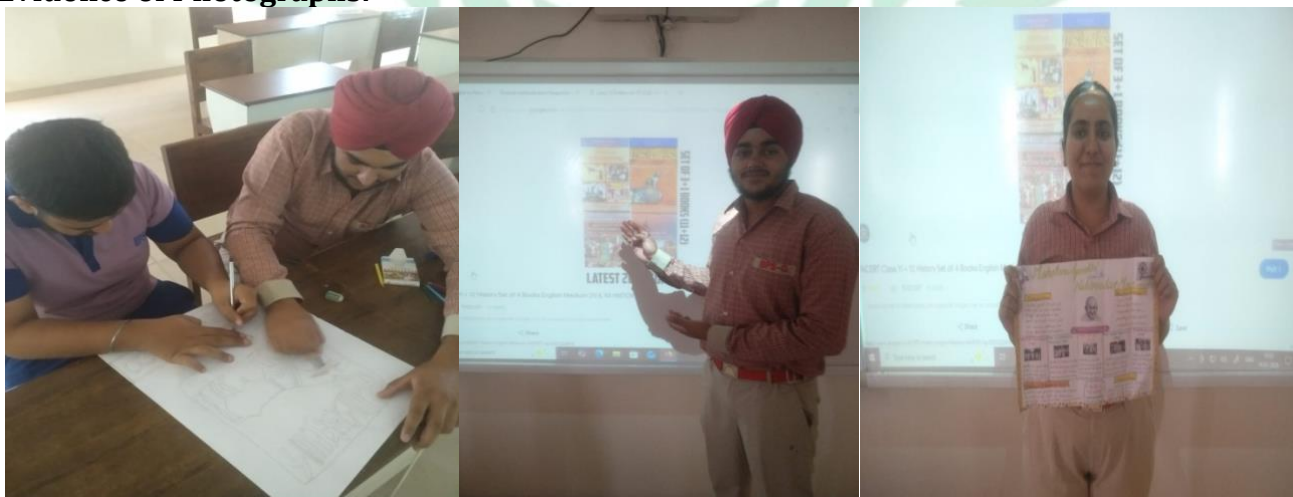
