Long Answer Type Questions (LA) carry 5 marks each. Answers to each question should not exceed 120 words. 7. Case-Based Questions (CBQ) consist of sub-questions and carry 4 marks each. Answers to each question should not exceed 100 words. 8. Map-Based Questions carry 5 marks in total and have two parts: Q9 – Section A: History – 2 Marks Q19 – Section B: Geography – 3 Marks 9.
