Birla Public School Students Embark on Educational Exposure Visit

Sri Ganganagar, July 16, 2026:

Birla Public School, Ganganagar, organized an educational exposure visit for students of Classes III to VIII with the objective of providing experiential learning beyond the classroom. The programme was conducted **under the able guidance of Vice Principal Mrs. Sushila Saharan and Headmistress Mrs. Akanksha Khullar**, whose careful planning and supervision ensured the successful execution of the visit.

A total of **248 students** enthusiastically participated in the educational tour under the supervision of **32 teachers**.

Students of **Classes III to V** were divided into groups and visited **IDFC First Bank (Near Meera Chowk), AU Bank (Shiv Chowk), and AU Bank (Ravinder Chowk)** to gain practical knowledge about banking operations and financial literacy. A total of **125 students**, accompanied by **23 teachers**, learnt about banking services, digital transactions, account opening procedures, ATM facilities, cash management, and the importance of saving and responsible financial practices through interactive sessions conducted by bank officials.

Meanwhile, **123 students of Classes VI to VIII**, accompanied by **9 teachers**, visited **Tantia University** for an enriching educational experience. During the visit, the students explored the **Faculty of Law**, where they gained valuable insights into the Indian legal system, important Articles of the Constitution, fundamental laws, and the role of legal professionals in society. They also visited the **Moot Court Room**, where they observed how courtroom proceedings are conducted and understood the practical aspects of legal education.

The students further explored the **Nursing Faculty Laboratories, Anatomy Lab and Museum**, and the **Skill Lab**, where they learnt about human anatomy, healthcare practices, patient care techniques, and modern medical training equipment. The visit to the **University Library** introduced them to a vast collection of academic resources and highlighted the importance of research and reading in higher education. They also visited the **Auditorium**, where they were acquainted with the university's cultural and academic activities.
